

An example with some serif text in Times New Roman thanks to the `timesnps` package. For maths, the package `mathptmx` must be called so that Times (not Times New Roman) is used for letters in formulae, yielding

$$\int_a^b \frac{dx}{x} = \ln \frac{|b|}{|a|}$$

And now some sans-serif text in Arial thanks to the `arial` package. This package is as found on CTAN in 2003, and does not include sophisticated features for rescaling Arial to match the size of the serif font, as does the package `helvet` for Helvetica.
