

Secretary's Report 2011

Renewal for members continuing from 2010 to 2011 was £10, and this caused a small number of members to choose not to renew. As was the case last year, a small number of people (less than ten) did not respond despite a number of attempts to contact them, and so were removed from our membership list.

We have held two a very successful 'Beginner's LaTeX' courses this year. One of the benefits of the course was automatic membership of UK-TUG, and as a result our membership now stands at 156 members (there were 166 members at the same stage last year).

Joint membership of UK-TUG and TUG remains popular: 46 members have joint membership, one more than in my report last year.
