

2. The Intellects and the celestial spheres⁵⁸



Rāḥat al-ʿaql does not make clear the hierarchical rank of the potential Intellect which proceeds from the first simultaneously with the second. Probably it is to be identified with the tenth Intellect, as it operates as the demiurge of our material, sublunary world. Later Ismāʿīlī interpretations of *Rāḥat al-ʿaql* – for instance by the Yemenite Ṭayyibī author Ibrāhīm b. al-Ḥusayn al-Ḥāmidī (d. 557/1162) in his *Kitāb Kanz al-Walad* – state that the potential Intellect was originally the third, but emanating si-
