Use of `\pauselevel`

- Level 1 (appears from the start) ■
 - Level 2 ■
 - Level 3 ■
- Level 1 as well ■
 - Level 4... ■
 - Level 5. ■

Use of `\pauselevel{:t}`

- This item appears at level 1 and stays ■
- This item appears at level 2 and vanishes after level 4. ■
- Level 3 ■
- Level 4 ■
- Level 5 ■

Highlighting

- This slide is build in `\pausehighlight` mode■
- Every line appears from the beggining,■
 - and is highlighted incrementally■
- You can highlight out of order,■
- of course.■
- That's it.■

Highlighting *and* incremental build

- First item...■ And we want to come back to this later.■
- This is highlighted for 2 levels.■
- (Note the different highlighting color.)■
- Remember that first item?■
- We can discuss it now.■
- Done.■
