With the standard classes and with KOMA-Script all title pages are dened in a special environment, the `titlepage` environment. This environment always starts a new page in the two-sided layout a new right page. For this page, the style is changed as by, so that neither page number nor running title are output. At the end of the environment the page is automatically shipped out. Should you not be able to use the automatic layout of the title page, it is advisable to design a new one with the help of this environment.

In earlier times the inner book was often not protected from dirt by a cover. This task was then taken over by the rst page of the book which carried mostly a shortened title, precisely the half-title. Nowadays the extra page is often applied before the real full title and contains information on the publisher, series number and similar information.
